Dear Mr. Esterer:

Thank you for your letter of February 7th. I do not think that my letter, answering your letter would be in your hands before you go to Cleveland.

You can speak to Mr. Hauche and introduce my wines to the State of Ohio. We can make some arrangement that you shall have some think for your job also.

For your state I can give maybe 150 to 200 cases of my Riesling spatlese 1964 and may be the same amount of Riesling 1965. The Pinot Chardonnay we can offer him only 100 cases of each. An other varieties there can be available only as follows:

Gewurztraminer 50 cases, Pinot Noir and Cabernet Sauvignon as well as Gamay Beaujolais only 15 cases of each.

The total number shall be not more than 400 cases.

If you and Mr. Hauche will become interested we can arrange a day to discuss this problem.

How is doing you Home Wine Making.
